Description <p>I have accessed the BHPS data from the UKDA (version SN 3909 -British Household Panel Survey Derived Current and Annual Net Household Income Variables, Waves 1-18, 1991-2009), and am looking for some advice on the proposed analysis. I want to identify, for any given year, households that are below 60 per cent of contemporary median income, after housing costs (i.e. equivalent to the HBAI variable "LOW60AHC").
