Dear Marina,

We don't have this data for most children. There was a question, `f_bornuk`, in Wave 6 which asked if an individual was born in the UK or not, but this was only asked of IEMB households. It was asked as part of the household grid, so included all members of those households. The variable can be found in `f_indall`.

If you are interested in country within the UK then you could decide to assume that the child was born in the country where the mother lives, and this would give you data for children who have been born since the beginning of the survey.
