The variable you need to match the two ca\_indresp\_w with any individual level file in Wave 9 is pidp. If you match ca\_indresp\_w with i\_indresp using pidp then 15990 cases match. Here is the Stata syntax I used to match the two files:

use ca\_indresp\_w, clear merge 1:1 pidp using i\_indresp
