You will have to link back youth data from Covid19 (cW\_youth\_p) to INDALL files in the main data (W\_indall) which will include PIDP of their parents (W\_fnpid & W\_mnpid for biological parents OR W\_fnspid & W\_mnspid for bio/step/adop parents). You can use these identifiers to then link back to adult respondent file in Covid19 survey (cW\_indresp\_w) to link to their parents.

You will be able to identify the father or mother of all but 5 youths in cd\_youth\_p file. Then if you link with cd\_indresp\_w using these identifiers you will be able to find at least one parent in this file for 823 youths.
