Hello Mario,

To merge INDRESP and HHRESP use HIDP

To merge INDRESP and YOUTH - there is no point doing this as those who are in INDRESP are not in YOUTH

TO merge JOBHIST and INDRESP use PIDP. But note that JOBHIST is a multilevel file where for each person (identified by PIDP) there are as many rows as jobs each identified by JSPNO. So, each row is identified by PIDP br\_JSPNO. You need to first decide what you want to do with the information in JOBHIST before simply merging with INDRESP.
