Hello Abigail,

To understand this you should look at w\_indall as it includes everyone who have been enumerated to be in the household. Most of those with missing w\_ppid==-8 but in a partnership (w\_mastat\_dv=2,3,10), are either (i) not living with a spouse (w\_livesp\_dv=2) or (ii) w\_livesp=-8. Almost all of (ii) are actually people living in single person households (w\_livesp not asked if living in a single person household for obvious reasons). Both of these situations imply that the person's partner is not part of the household.

As long as the partner is enumerated in the household they will have a w\_ppid. If they don't give an adult interview they will not show up in w\_indresp, but will show up in w\_ppid of their partner. So, the only reason someone in a partnership does not have w\_ppid is because they are not living with their partner (w\_livesp=2 or -8).

Hope this helps.
