So far, I noticed that there are two variables on individual gross labour income that are highly comparable (fimnl and fimnlabgrs), but not for the net labour income.			
If you could also guide me in constructing a variable for net labour income for BHPS that is highly comparable with the one of UKHLS, this would be really helpful.
