Basic information about all household members of households that responded/enumerated are recorded in the file bW\_indall (a for Wave 1, b for Wave 2,...). If you want to identify children this is the file to use. All those who are 16+ year old are eligible for adult interviews and if they agree to participate then their responses are recorded in bW\_indresp file - this file will not include anyone below the age of 16. From onwards Wave 4 of the BHPS, 11-15 year olds were eligible for a short self-completion youth questionnaire and if they agreed to participate those responses are recorded in bW\_youth.
