The mental health of children has been assessed using the Strength and Difficulties Questionnaire (SDQ) and the parents' mental health has been evaluated using the General Health Questionnaire (GHQ). SDQ and GHQ are both give me scores that indicate mental health. When I merge the three datasets of each wave alone using 'pidp', I ended up with SDQ just for children and GHQ just for adults and missing in both. Therefore, I couldn't run the analysis.  How can I merge the datasets of children with their parents using SPSS, so I can run a correlation test between SDQ and GHQ?  Many thanks.
