The wave 10 fieldwork spanned over 2.5 years, so from Jan 2018 to May 2020, you can check the individual interview date using the `j_intdatd_dv`, `j_intdatm_dv`, `j_intdaty_dv` variables, and the household interview date using `j_histrtdaty`, `j_histrtdatm`, `j_histrtdatd` and `j_hienddaty`, `j_hienddatm`, `j_hienddatd`.
