If you want to know who gets asked a particular question please refer to the questionnaire. If you look at the Wave 10 questionnaire "<https://www.understandingsociety.ac.uk/sites/default/files/downloads/documentation/mainstage/questionnaire/wave-10/W10-questionnaire-consultation.pdf>" you will see that the material deprivation questions (matdepa...) are in the household questionnaire and asked of households where there is at least one child below 15 years.

To know which questionnaire a question is included look below the question text and you will see a field "Module". In this case it says "Module Household_W10. Household Questionnaire"

To know who gets asked a question, look below the question text and you will see a field "Universe". In this case it says "/// One or more children aged 0 to 15 in the household OR no children aged 0 to 15 in the household and nobody of pensionable age in the household"
