Combining b\_indresp\_ns and c\_indresp\_ns there are approx 20,000 individuals. Of these around 1900 are ethnic minorities (racel\_dv>1) and 1200 non-white ethnic minorities (racel\_dv>1). Please note that the ethnic minority boost sample was not included for the nurse visits.
