To see if the household is in an institution, use `dweltyp` (`hhsamp`) for CAPI, and whether the respondent is currently living in an institution use `dwltype` (`indall`) for CATI and CAWI and then `instdet` (`indall`) to identify what institution this is. However, please note that due to a lot of practical limitations related to interviewing people in institutions, the number of such interviews is very low, so might not be enough for a research project.
