<p>I am a Research Fellow at Cardiff University working on a project funded by Healthy Working Wales (HWW) of Public Health Wales (PHW). Over the last few years, commissioned by PHW, the project team have developed and piloted an online 'employee tool'; a survey that, once completed, is reported back to employers and can be used to understand the health and wellbeing needs of their workforce. We have used and adapted questions from a number of national and international surveys, including UKLHS.
