In wave 2 these questions were asked differently than it was done later in the study, that is, only in wave 2 and only of the sample months from May 2010 to December 2010 (if (month = 5 Thru 12)), so we didn't cover the whole sample. In later waves, we did try to ask this question of the whole sample, thus the questions were asked across more than one wave.
