If you use Adobe Acrobat Reader, then you can search many files at once using "Advanced Search". You can also use the variable search function on our website (<https://www.understandingsociety.ac.uk/documentation/mainstage/variables/>), but please be aware that the website was migrated to a different platform last week and we are still working on making the search function fully functional, so it's better to check the questionnaires for some time.
