It should be the same variable you mentioned. The Study introduces an improvement in the employment-related content. From Wave 13, the questionnaire design allows up to 16 jobs to be reported and the "Second jobs" module is no longer asked. Therefore, you may have multiple jobs and wouldn't make sense to say that you're employed part-time. However, we use the main job variable to produce jbft\_dv. We'll amend this variable as soon as possible. In the meantime, you can run the syntax code to produce this variable.
