The information in indresp refers to the main job. Information on multiple jobs is now stored in the "employment" file, which is in long format and contains one record per job. It includes the main job (identified by o\_jbmain; the main job is not necessarily job 1) as well as any additional jobs. This file is now available from wave 13 onwards (that is, from the moment the Multiple jobs module started).
