I am looking at wave 15, doing an output for the mean, median, minimum and maximum I found that the mean is lower than on the website due to a discrepancy between the maximum amount a respondent gave on the dataset and website.			
On the dataset, the maximum amount o_fihmngrs_dv features is 48615.1 whereas on the website it is 398195.9
