I'm trying to reconcile income data from US with comparable data from the Family Resources Survey / HBAI 2009/10.

There are two household income variables in US hh\_resp: a\_fihhmngrs\_dv and a\_fihhmnnet\_dv. These are described as 'gross' and 'net' household income in the past month - but not what the second is 'net' of (taxes? housing costs?).

I can't find is any further explanation, or description of how they are derived from the detailed income data - grateful for any help.
