Follow these steps:

- 1. Merge youth questionnaire file, w\_youth, to w\_indall using pidp. The variables that you need from w\_indall are the mother and father PIDPs: w\_mnspid and w\_fnspid
- 2. Drop observations in w\_indall but not in w\_youth and save it, say as temp\_youth
- 3. Open temp\_youth, rename pidp to something else say, youth\_pidp
- 4. Rename mother pidp, w mnspid, to pidp
- 5. Merge that file with w\_indresp using pidp and keep whatever mother variables you need (note this will be a many to one merge for households with youth siblings)
- 6. Rename pidp back to w\_mnspid
- 7. Save it as mother file, w\_mother
- 8. Repeat steps 3-8 for father: w\_father
- 9. Now merge these two files, w\_mother and w\_father, to temp\_youth file using w\_mnspid and w\_fnspid

Please remember to check the output at each step.
