- 1. there is no variable SCEVERDRNK. i've been advised by a colleague that those who are assigned inapplicable or -8 on SCAGE1DRINK are the people who never had an alcoholic drink (as described as Q31 in the questionnaire). is this a correct assumption?
- 2. assuming #1, i proceed to create a binary variable for those who have never drank (-8's from above) and those who have had a drink. when i weight this variable with b\_indscus\_xw, then i lose the 'never drinkers' or -8. they do not have a weight value. i was advised from a previous user support question that this is the right weight to use. but now i'm stuck because i lose my 'never drinkers' if the latter is assumed correctly from '-8'. what should i do?
