that's almost correct. To be precise: there are two different versions of the socio-economic classifications and their names are consistent. The standard end-user licence data have condensed codes and the variable names end on \_cc (in this case \_jbsic07\_cc). Then there is the Special license version of the data which includes the full socio-economic classification code (in this case \_jbsic07) and is made available to users who can make a convincing case that they need to access more detailed information (i.e., subject to approval).
