all questions asked in the interview are included in the questionnaire which we make available online as a PDF. The cognitive development questions are included in Wave 3 and if you look at the questionnaire you will find that the questions are in the cognitive development module. The questionnaires can be searched using Ctrl+F and the question names correspond to variable names in the data. There are also a number of derived variables, which all start on _cg for convenience; in addition all variable labels include "cognitive ability:" so I am not sure why you struggle to find the relevant variables in the data. Are you looking at the Understanding Society mainstage data or at the IP or Health Assessment data perhaps?

As to which information is available on physical exercise, please also check the questionnaires. I don't think there is a special module in this in Wave 3 but adjacent waves may offer what you are looking for.
