Dear Helen,

Many thanks for your enquiry.

1 – we would include respondents in these types of accommodation, that is we would follow them if they moved into these types of accommodation and seek to interview them there. There is a variable `w_dweltyp` in the `w_hhsamp` data file. This does have some response categories which may be relevant (code 13 = sheltered accommodation, and from Wave 2 code 14 = institution).

2 – in the annual events history we ask about residential mobility, so if a participant has moved house in the last year we collect some information here, including the date of move. We also collect information about people who move in and out of the household in the household grid (`w_indall`).
