I'm sorry for the delay in getting back to you.

Unfortunately we have not included individual net income in the data sets and do not readily have access to it at the moment. The data set does include employee pay net of taxes (wPAYNU), we do not include other components of individual income net.

We are looking at expanding the range of measures as part of a programme of work to harmonise the BHPS data with that for UKHLS (which does include individual net income) and will take note of this request, but it is unlikely it can be addressed before the end of the year.
