Dear Olly,

The values should add up correctly subject to a bit of rounding error (maximum value 1.25p), but it does depend a bit what exactly you have done.

In principle  $fimngrs\_dv = fimnlabgrs\_dv + fibenothr\_dv + (fyrinvinc/12)$  and this seems to work.

There is a slight glitch at wave 6 since there are numbers of cases of `fyrinvinc` missing (-9). Setting these to zero, the above formula works.
